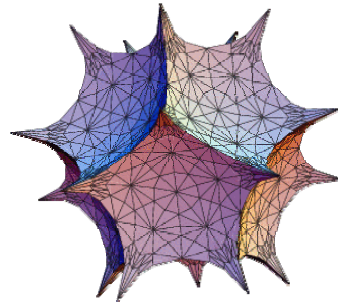


MATH TUTORING

What is it?

- A **FREE** tutorial service for all ARCC students
- **NO** appointment needed, it is a **WALK IN** service
- It should not be thought of as a **LAST** resort
- A place to get additional help

Who is it for?

- All ARCC students

Who are the tutors?

- ARCC students that have been successful in mathematics

What should you bring?

- Your specific and general questions
- Textbook
- Class notes (so the tutor can see what you have been working on in class)
- Homework
- Calculator if applicable
- A willingness to learn

What can I expect from the tutor center?

- Tutors will help you revisit ideas and topics that you have covered in class
- Tutors will not reteach an entire lesson if you were absent
- A tutor will **NOT** do your homework for you, but they **WILL** help you get started
- The tutor center is not a place to have someone correct your homework, but the tutors will help to make sure you are on the right track
- The math tutors have taken math courses at ARCC and can give you hints/help on how to be successful. This includes note taking advice, how to study for a test, and how to read a math textbook, etc.
- The tutors will want **SPECIFIC QUESTIONS**. Don't say "I don't get it". It might be better to see the instructor if you are totally lost
- It is a place to work on homework and talk to a tutor when a problem comes up
- Tutors work the full semester, so you can have consistency in who helps you on a daily/weekly basis
