- Obtain a **Letter of Recommendation** from an instructor, work supervisor or colleague (non-family member) for submission.
- If you are selected as a scholarship recipient, you will be required to maintain full-time student status and enroll in a 1-credit CSEMS Scholar Seminar each semester of the grant award.
