You may not use a calculator, notes, textbooks any or other papers. Scratch paper will be provided to you and may not be removed from the room.

This is an adaptive test which means the computer will automatically decide the next question to give you based on your responses to previous questions. This enables the computer to find the individual level of difficulty that is correct for you. Because of the adaptability you cannot omit any question or come back to change an answer later. The test is not timed so you can think about each question thoroughly. If you do not know an answer to a question, try to eliminate one or more choices and make an educated guess to the correct answer.
